However, it is necessary to hand the items rather than throwing them to the spectators. Our concern lies with safety of the children who run into the street to "catch" the goodies. Please have someone walk the route beside your unit to hand the items to the crowd.

A leader must sign in at the registration table.

Horse Units must provide a clean-up crew directly behind unit for entire parade route.

You **must** include the signed liability waiver with your entry.
